Big Idea

We can reverse the curse of sin by becoming a new creation in Christ.

Icebreaker

Do you hold on to old items? What's one thing you probably don't need any more but insist on keeping?

Discussion Questions

Read Acts 9:3-6. Refer to all of chapter 9 for this discussion.

- I. What did the curse of sin look like in Saul's life? How can our sin affect others?
- 2. Why did Jesus give the response that Saul was persecuting him? What does that say about how much Jesus loves his followers?
- 3. Have you ever felt too far gone? How does Paul's story give you a different perspective on that?
- 4. What does Paul's conversion story have to do with baptism? Is baptism a requirement for Christians? Why or why not?

Concluding Question

Read **2 Corinthians 5:17**. What does it mean to be a "new creation?" How does this reverse the curse of sin? Do you feel like you are a new creation? How can you live in that reality this week?

- 1. What do you think the Holy Spirit may be saying to you through this sermon and our discussion?
- 2. What is something God wants you to do now?
- 3. Is there a way we can help each other apply what God is showing us?
